**APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR NOVEMBER 7, 2016 MEETING**

Councilman Lammlein made motion to accept minutes for November 7, 2016 meeting, second by Councilwoman Chalfant. The motion in favor of passed unanimously, 6 to 0.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Councilman Lammlein made motion to purchase two new buses, second by Councilwoman Pollard. The motion in favor of passed unanimously, 6 to 0. **SECOND READING AND PUBLIC HEARING OF ORDINANCE 18-2016 – AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING REVISIONS REPEALING AND REPLACING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF EXISTING OLDHAM COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE** Steve Emery, City Attorney, read Ordinance 18-2016. Councilwoman Zimlich made motion to approve Ordinance 18-2016, second by Councilman Lammlein. Councilwoman Pollard made motion to go into public hearing, second by Councilwoman Chalfant and Councilman Lammlein. The motion in favor of passed unanimously, 6 to 0. Jim Urban with Oldham County Planning and Development explained some of the additions to comprehensive zoning. Councilwoman Pollard made motion to go out of public hearing, second by Councilman Kamer. The motion in favor of passed unanimously, 6 to 0. Discussion among City Council. Mayor Davenport calls for vote: Chalfant-yes, Pottie-yes, Kamer-yes, Lammlein-yes, Zimlich-yes and Pollard-yes. The motion in favor of passed unanimously, 6 to 0.

**OLD BUSINESS/NEW BUSINESS** Councilman Kamer made motion for a memo of understanding to be executed by Mayor Davenport, and the motion to accept Billy Doelker's offer and go forward with the sale of property and to authorize Mayor Davenport to sign all necessary documents, be rescinded; having no further effect, second by Councilwoman Zimlich. The motion in favor of passed unanimously, 6 to 0.
