

WRITTEN DETERMINATION FOR DISPOSAL OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statute (KRS) 82.083 states in pertinent part:

- (1) A city may sell or otherwise dispose of any of its real or personal property.
- (2) Before selling or otherwise disposing of any real or personal property, the city shall make a written determination setting forth and fully describing:
 - (a) The real or personal property;
 - (b) Its intended use at the time of acquisition;
 - (c) The reasons why it is in the public interest to dispose of it; and
 - (d) The method of disposition to be used.

THEREFORE, the following written determination is hereby set forth and made:

- A. The City owns certain personal property. Specifically, a 1997 Silver Ford Crown Victoria VIN# 2FALP71WXVX151060; a 2004 Ford Explorer Black and White VIN# 1FMZU72K14UA91776; a 2006 Ford Crown Victoria Black and White VIN# 2FAFP71W46X109076; and a 2007 Ford Crown Victoria Black and White VIN# 2FAFP71W67X131887.
- B. The City intended to use these as police vehicles at the time of acquisition, and that intended use was fulfilled.
- C. It is in the public interest to dispose of this property. The cost of continued storage exceeds the value to the City.
- D. These vehicles will be sold at public auction.

This written determination is hereby adopted as true by the legislative body of the City of La Grange, Kentucky.
