**MODIFYING § 110.02 CONCERNING BUSINESS LICENSE  
APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

**Whereas**, the City Council of the City of La Grange, Kentucky, has the authority pursuant to statute to enact Ordinances relating to the City, and

**Whereas**, it is desirable that the terms concerning vendors and peddlers who are invited to be a part of events hosted by not for profit organizations established under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code be included, and

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED THAT § 110.02 OF  
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BE MODIFIED AS FOLLOWS:**

Every person and business entity engaged in any business in the City of La Grange shall be required to apply for and obtain a business license from the City of La Grange before the commencement of business or in the event of a change of business status. Every food service establishment and/or retail food service establishment, as defined in KRS 217.015, in the City of La Grange shall be required to present proof of their/its permit from the Kentucky Cabinet for Health Services as described in 902 KAR 45:110, and proof of inspection as issued by the Oldham County Health Department in accordance with the Kentucky Food Code, for reproduction by the City, when application is tendered for a business license. Further, mobile food service establishments (food trucks or similar mobile food service establishments) shall pay a flat fee business license tax only, and the license shall be for 90 days or one year. The flat fee for the 90 day license is \$100.00, and the flat fee for the one year license is \$350.00. Mobile food service establishments (food trucks or similar mobile food service establishments) may not park on a city right of way. Any such violation will result in a fine (see schedule below) and shall result in a suspension of the right to conduct business in the City of La Grange for 30 days. A stop work order will be issued against that business if this occurs.

However, notwithstanding the preceding terms of the code, all vendors and peddlers who are invited to be a part of an event organized by a

not for profit 501(c) (3) organization, held within the city limits of La Grange, Kentucky, and have in their possession proof of invitation issued by that duly authorized not for profit 501(c) (3) organization, shall not be required to have or obtain a business or peddlers license from the City for that event.

Fine schedule:

First offense - a fine of \$50.00, if paid within 30 days of citation; and additional \$50.00 if not paid within 30 days of citation, plus interest at the rate of 1% per month, compounded monthly.

Second offense - a fine of \$100.00, if paid within 30 days of citation; and additional \$100.00 if not paid within 30 days of citation, plus interest at the rate of 1% per month, compounded monthly.

Third offense - a fine of \$500.00, if paid within 30 days of citation; and additional \$500.00 if not paid within 30 days of citation, plus interest at the rate of 1% per month, compounded monthly.

If a civil action is filed to collect an imposed fine and/or interest, or to enforce a stop work order, then attorney fees or legal costs incurred by the City shall be recovered from the violator and awarded to the City by the Court.

Licensees are required to notify the city of any changes in address, the cessation of business, or any other changes that render the information supplied to the city in the license application, inaccurate.
