

ORDINANCE NO. 16 SERIES 2017  
CITY OF LA GRANGE, KENTUCKY

**MODIFYING §§ 50.03 AND 50.06 CONCERNING LA GRANGE  
UTILITY COMMISSION**

**Whereas**, the City Council of the City of La Grange, Kentucky, has the authority pursuant to statute to enact Ordinances relating to the City, and

**Whereas**, it is desirable that specific terms concerning compensation of commissioners and reports to city council be amended.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED THAT §§ 50.03 AND 50.06 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BE MODIFIED AS FOLLOWS:**

§ 50.03 COMPENSATION.

The Utility Commission shall determine the compensation to be paid to its members not exceeding ~~the amount~~ an annual salary of thirty-six hundred dollars (\$3,600.00) per commissioner per annum, except that each commissioner who completes during a calendar year a minimum of six (6) instructional hours (year 1) of water or sewer utility management training approved by the Public Service Commission, Division of Water, or equivalent municipal utility training, may receive an annual salary of not more than forty-eight hundred dollars (\$4,800) for year one. Each commissioner who completes during the following calendar year an additional six (6) instructional hours (consecutive year 2) of water or sewer utility management training approved by the Public Service Commission,

Division of Water, or equivalent municipal utility training, may receive an annual salary of not more than six thousand dollars (\$6,000) for year two.

Each commissioner who continues to complete during the following calendar year and consecutive years beyond an additional six (6)

instructional hours (year 3 and beyond) of water or sewer utility

management training approved by the Public Service Commission, Division of Water, or equivalent municipal utility training may continue to receive an annual salary of not more than six thousand dollars (\$6,000). ~~which salaries~~

The chairman shall receive an additional sixty dollars (\$60) per month as an expense reimbursement. These amounts shall constitute a cost of operation and maintenance of the waterworks system, sewer system and other utilities.

The city shall not be liable for the payment of any salary or compensation of any of the members of the Utility Commission, or for the payment of the salary or compensation or expenses of any person employed by the Utility Commission, and such salaries, compensation and expenses, and any and all liabilities of whatever kind or character, incurred by the Utility Commission or any officer or employee thereof shall be paid solely and only out of the revenue obtained from the Utility Commission from the various utilities owned by the city pursuant to the law, and the liabilities shall be so limited.

§ 50.06 POWERS AND DUTIES.

Parts (A), (B), (C), and (D) remain the same.

(E) La Grange Utilities Report must continue to remain as a line item on the agenda for the regularly scheduled City Council Meeting(s) and representation from La Grange Utilities must attend in person at said meetings.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
