

**COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY

RESOLUTION NO. 1 - 2016**

**ENCOURAGING THE COMMONWEALTH TO UNDERTAKE
STUDY OF CROSSWALKS WITHIN THE CITY OF LA GRANGE
TO FIND SAFER ALTERNATIVES**

WHEREAS, the City of La Grange, Kentucky (the "City") is a home rule city in the Commonwealth of Kentucky;

WHEREAS, there are roadway intersections, and typically used unmarked pedestrian crossings, in the City on State-Controlled Roadways (namely Highway 146, also known as Jefferson Street, and Highway 53, also known as First Avenue and First Street) that have proven to be hazardous to pedestrians, and serious injury and death have occurred of late as a result; and,

WHEREAS, it is important to the safety and welfare of the City, its residents, and visitors, to have safe pedestrian passage with the city limits;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF LA GRANGE,
KENTUCKY THAT:**

1. The City Council encourages all appropriate Departments of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Governor Matt Bevin, and our elected State officials (Senator Ernie Harris and Congressman David Osborne) take all necessary steps to investigate safe alternatives to the present pedestrian passage ways within the City of La Grange on State-Controlled Roadways, including, but not limited to, the intersection of Highway 146 and Highway 53, Highway 53 and Main Street, Highway 53 at 502 South First Street, and Highway 146 at 307 West Jefferson Street.
